Early Years Foundation Stage 2022/2023

Every year the average attainment of children arriving in Nursery is significantly below the expected standard. Especially in Communication and Language which in turn has a detrimental impact upon all other areas of the curriculum. This was even more so with the intake of children into EYFS due to many different factors related to covid and attendance.

EYFS Summary of attainment- Children achieving a GLD in all Prime and Specific areas.

KS1

Year One Phonics 2022/2023

Phonics continues to be very strong with 93% of Year 1 children successfully passing in Year 1. This is an increase on previous years and significantly higher than last year's national average.

End of KS1 Assessment

End of KS1 assessment results are strong. They have improved significantly on last year's results and are above the national averages for last academic year.

- 19% of children achieved the greater depth standard for maths.

- 69% of children achieved the expected standard or better for reading.
- 38% of children achieved the greater depth standard for reading.

Writing

- 69% of children achieved the expected standard or better for writing.
- 7% of children achieved the greater depth standard for writing.

Mathematics

- 69% of children achieved the expected standard or better for maths.
- 19% of children achieved the greater depth standard for maths

SPAG

- 69% of children achieved the expected standard or better for SPAG.
- 31% of children achieved the greater depth standard for SPAG.
