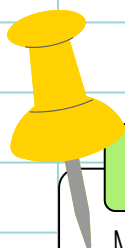


BACK TO SCHOOL

WHAT WE WILL BE LEARNING

This half term we will be exploring the Learning Challenge 'What will we find in Little Red Riding Hood's forest?', focusing on the story of Little Red Riding Hood by M. Alperin.

We are looking forward to the many opportunities that this text and question will give us and have created areas in the classroom, particularly for the Early Years children, which provide activities which link not only to Little Red Riding Hood but to other traditional tales also.

In literacy we will be really looking in depth at the story using our senses to expand on our vocabulary. We will be linking this to our science topic, which will look closely at animals and humans and give the children the opportunity to discuss their own pets.

REMINDERS
